

LOTHIAN & BORDERS TARGET SHOOTING ASSOCIATION

CHOOSE YOUR OWN HANDICAP TEAM COMPETITION

Open to teams of four from Affiliated Clubs.

PRIZES: 1st - Burton Cup and medals.
 2nd - medals.

CONDITIONS

1. A Club may enter any number of teams which shall be designated A, B, C etc. and which need not be in average or any other order. Teams will consist of three shooters.
2. The minimum Start is 5. Each team member must take a Start, and team members names and their chosen Start must be given on the entry form. Should a nominated team member not be able to shoot, the reserve who takes his/her place must accept the registered Start of the member for whom he/she is a substitute. When the cards are scored, the start will be added to the gunscore. If the total exceeds 100 then the amount by which 100 is exceeded shall be deducted from 100. Any penalties incurred will be applied to the adjusted score.
3. A competitor may shoot for one team only throughout the competition.
4. Teams will be drawn randomly in pairs and knock-out conditions will apply. If a tie occurs then graduated gauges will be used on all cards for both teams and the Starts re-applied to all scores until a result is found.
5. Each round except the final shall be shot under postal conditions. The final round, if circumstances and travelling conditions permit, shall be shot shoulder-to-shoulder on a neutral range appointed by the Management Committee and the match overseen and scored by the competition's Secretary.
6. Each team member may shoot his/her card at any time from receipt of the stickers until the specified last date for shooting. Cards for this team competition may not be shot concurrently with cards for the CYOH Individual competition.
7. Each card must be witnessed. The competitor must sign and the witness must sign and date the card at the completion of the shooting.
8. 30 counting shots per team per round, consisting of 10 shots per team member at one N.S.R.A. (1989) ten-bull indoor target. Electronic targets may not be used.
9. No sighting shots are allowed.
10. Cards must be sent to the competition's Secretary for scoring to reach him/her not later than the Saturday following the last date for shooting on penalty of disqualification. Local scoring is not permitted.
11. Stickers for each round will be issued by the competition's Secretary. Stickers must be affixed to the front of each card before shooting.
12. A stamped addressed envelope should be provided if a copy of the results is required otherwise results will be emailed to club contacts. The results will be posted on the Association's website as they become available.
13. At least two weeks will be allowed for the shooting of each round.
14. The decision of the Management Committee shall be final in the event of any dispute arising.
15. Unless otherwise stated, N.S.R.A. Rules currently in force will apply.

Open to members of Affiliated Clubs.

PRIZES: 1st – The Dundas Salver and medal.
 2nd - medal

CONDITIONS

1. A Club may enter any number of individuals as desired.
2. There is no minimum Start. Each entrant must take a Start which must be given on the entry form. When the cards are scored, the start will be added to the gunscore. If the total exceeds 100 then the amount by which 100 is exceeded shall be deducted from 100. Any penalties incurred will be applied to the adjusted score.
3. Entrants will be drawn randomly in pairs and knock-out conditions will apply. If a tie occurs then graduated gauges will be used on both cards and the Starts re-applied until a result is found.
4. Each round shall be shot under postal conditions.
5. Entrants may shoot his/her card at any time from receipt of the stickers until the specified last date for shooting. Cards for this Individual competition may not be shot concurrently with cards for the CYOH Team competition.
6. Each card must be witnessed. The competitor must sign and the witness must sign and date the card at the completion of the shooting.
7. 10 counting shots per competitor per round on one N.S.R.A. (1989) ten-bull indoor target. Electronic targets may not be used.
8. No sighting shots are allowed.
9. Cards must be sent to the competition's Secretary for scoring to reach him/her not later than the Saturday following the last date for shooting on penalty of disqualification. Local scoring is not permitted.
10. Stickers for each round will be issued by the competition's Secretary. Stickers must be affixed to the front of each card before shooting.
11. A stamped addressed envelope should be provided if a copy of the results is required otherwise results will be emailed to club contacts. The results will be posted on the Association's website as they become available.
12. At least two weeks will be allowed for the shooting of each round.
13. The decision of the Management Committee shall be final in the event of any dispute arising.
14. Unless otherwise stated, N.S.R.A. Rules currently in force will apply.
